The network is co-financed by the **European Social Fund in Spain**, within the 2014-2020 Social Inclusion and Social Economy Operative Programme, as a transnational cooperation project.

WHO CAN BE A MEMBER?

The European Network of Innovation for Inclusion is open to the participation of all those **entities, whether public or private**, whether for profit or not, which strive to make employment and entrepreneurship accessible to all groups at risk of exclusion, and **which are interested in innovating**.

WHY BECOME A MEMBER?

We are looking for coordinating entities in European countries to promote and stimulate the network at national level and that can finance their participation.

WHY BECOME A MEMBER?

Being a member of the network is completely **free**. If your organization becomes a member, you will have **access to all the activities of the network including the annual call for good practices** at European level in which you could participate either in the socio-labour inclusion category or in the inclusive entrepreneurship one.

If your organization is selected as a finalist, it will be invited (assuming the network all costs) to:

1. The **European event** where the awards ceremony will take place.
2. Participate in the **study visit** to the finalist entity of the corresponding category.
3. Be part of the **working group** for the design of projects of the corresponding category.

Furthermore, your organization will have access to information about European calls and partner searches between the members of the network for the presentation of projects, as well as the possibility to publish news about your activities, among others.

WHY BECOMING A COORDINATOR?

Being a coordinating entity involves a series of commitments with the purpose of promoting the activity of the network, but also benefits since it will bring **greater prestige to your entity** and will **increase the network of your collaborations**.

Some of the advantages are:

- Knowing at first hand the good practices presented and selected.
- Represent the network in other forums or European events.
- Participate in study visits to the best selected practices in each category every year.
- Participate in transnational working groups, in which European projects would be designed.
- Organize the European in your country.
- Participate in the decision making of the network, being part of the Steering Committee.

In order to participate as a coordinator in your country, **you will have to find your own funding**. You can either ask for funding to the European Social Fund (ESF) managing body from your country, or cover the costs of participation in this network by your own through or by other financing sources.
