




The Challenge...

Single-parent families face a higher risk of dealing with poverty and social exclusion. In 2016, the highest at-risk-of-poverty rate in the EU-28 was recorded for single-parents with dependent children, at more than one third. In particular, women are affected the most, as they make up almost 85% of all single-parent families in the EU.





A few words about parentbank

parentbank – 'Enhancing the social inclusion of low income single parents' is an Erasmus + Strategic Partnerhsips in Adult Education project, financed by the European Commission through A.N.P.C.D.E.F.P.

It has a duration of 2 years (2019-2021)

The project aims at facilitating the labor market integration of low-income single-parents by **promoting their access to childcare and other service** that they may be unable to afford through the time-banking (providing services to one another) and by **developing their skills** and entrepreneurial spirit, which can improve their employment status.



What is timebanking?

Time banking is a reciprocity-based work trading system in which hours are the currency. It is a form of community currency, which enables a person with one skillset to trade hours of work with someone with another skillset, without exchanging money.

To extend the competences of professionals, who support single parents, in the teaching of numeracy, entrepreneurial and digital skills

A single parents' online time bank piloted.

A guide for the development of a time-bank business plan and the developed sustainability strategy

A training programme for the building of literacy, numeracy, digital competences, sense of initiative, and entrepreneurial skills of low-skilled single parents.
